Consider an ordinance authorizing a Supplement to the Section 212 Agreement with Enterprise Products Operating, LLC, for the Brine Pond 5 and 6 Property and removing such properties from Industrial District No. 2.

PREFACE

This proposed ordinance authorizes a Supplement to the Section 212 Agreement (the "Agreement") with Enterprise Products Operating, LLC ("EPOLLC"), for Brine Pond 5 and 6 Property and removes such properties from Industrial District No. 2.

The Agreement with EPOLLC requires EPOLLC to add property to the Agreement prior to or within a reasonable time following commencement of construction of buildings, industrial plants or other structures on property within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction and not subject to the Agreement. To do so, EPOLLC must give the City notice of commencement of such construction and provide supplements for the parties to execute. On or about December 7, 2020, the City received a notice and supplement for the Brine Pond Property:

Additionally, at the time a Supplement for added property is executed, the City is required to remove any industrial district designation from such property. Therefore, this ordinance also removes the above-referenced property from Industrial District No. 2.
